

IF THE **О** ISN'T STRESSED IT PRONOUNCES AS **А**.

As an example we will take an adjective in different forms.

**ХОРОШО** - **good** is the common example to see how this rule works. So first two **Оs** aren't stressed and they are pronounced as **А**, the last one stays **О**, because it's stressed.

**ХОРОШИЙ** - **masculine good** the second **О** is stressed so it remains **О**, and the first one isn't, which makes it **А** in pronunciation.

Lets take another example – any word that ends with **ОГО**, in this case **ДВЕНАДЦАТОГО – ON TWELFTH**, which is ordinal number.

So in this case **ОГО** pronounces as **АВА**. It works with all ordinal numbers, which end on **ОГО**.
